

2010 Jim McLaughlin VOLLEYBALL Team Camp at UW

Information for Team Camp 1 from July 24th-26th and Team Camp 2 July 28th – 30th

****Residents** will need to **check in** to their dorm rooms between 7:00-8:15am. Bed linens and towels will be provided. If you do bring your own pillows, towels etc, please bring a color other than white. All rooms will have local telephone access with voice mail. There are TV lounges, kitchens with microwaves, laundry facilities and vending machines throughout the dorm. We will leave the dorm for the Arena as a group at 8:20 am ready for the rest of the day. Residents will be escorted as a group to/from the gymnasium with their team and coaching staff.

Residents will need to **check out** of the dorm on the last day of camp. All keys must be returned at that time to the staff at the front desk of the dorm. Campers are responsible for their own keys. ***A room key not returned will result in an immediate lock change and charge to YOU of \$85.00*** payable to University of Washington before you leave campus.

****Check-in for commuter** teams will be at the Arena beginning at 8:30am on the first morning. Players should plan to meet with their own coach as we will not have an individual check-in. Commuters should be dropped off at 8:30am and picked up at 9:00pm at the southwest corner of the Hec Ed Pavilion, closest to the Husky Team Store.

FOR ALL CAMPERS:

Camp will begin each morning at 9:00am and will end at 9:00pm on the first two days.

On the last day, we will have the final games of the tournament from 1-3:30pm, followed by closing ceremonies at 3:30 in the Hec Ed Pavilion /Bank of America Arena. Campers will be dismissed at 4:00pm. All parents and guests are invited to attend the entire afternoon session.

Lunch and dinner will be provided to all campers but only residents will eat breakfast in the dorm. There **will not** be a breakfast service for campers on the first day and there **will not** be a dinner service on the last day so please plan accordingly.

Each player needs to bring shoes, knee pads, water bottle (and shirts over sports bras) to camp each day. Please clearly mark each personal item with the camper's name. MacSports, LLC and the University of Washington will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. We do not anticipate any problems, but please do not bring valuables to camp.

Parking services has granted a 45 minute pick up and drop off window for camp. Parking rates on campus are \$16 Monday through Friday 6am-9 pm and Saturday 6am-through noon. Beginning in mid June, you can download a "drop-off" pass and find additional parking information at www.washington.edu/commuterservices/parking/camps_child_drop_off.php Campers who drive their own vehicles may purchase long term permits at the dorm during check-in. While just visiting, please use quarters for parking meters or stop by an attended parking booth for additional information. We have been warned that campers and parents will be ticketed for any violation of UW parking rules.
